- ◆ The Preacher tells us that nothing in our sphere of influence is permanent. Do we live as though that is true? How often do you invest yourself (time, money, resources, energy) in things that won't last?
- In contrast, everything that God does is permanent. If this is true, we would be wise to seek God's perspective and priorities. How are you seeking God's will for your life? What are you discovering about God's priorities for you and your family? What needs to change in your life to bring you into line with God's plan?
- ◆ Jesus said that the "the work of God [is] that you believe in Him whom He has sent." How important is the truth of the Gospel in your day-to-day activity? How does it influence your time? Your work? Your conversations? Are you generous, patient, full of love, compassionate and hating sin?
